## **The Big Event - Lumbre Chile Eating Contest**

### **Rules and Regulations:**

- 1. Contestants must be at least 18 years old.
- 2. Contestants will have 5 minutes to eat as many lumbre chiles as possible.
- 3. Contestants cannot remove chile seeds from lumbre chiles or alter lumber chile in any way.
- 4. Chile peppers must be eaten down to within 1/8 inch of the cap to be counted.
- 5. Only one chile may be eaten at a time.
- 6. The winner will be determined by the number of stems on the contestant's plate after time has been called.
- 7. Contestant will be allowed to drink water during the contest.
- 8. Contestants cannot coat the inside of their mouth with any kind of protective coating. Anyone caught will be disqualified.
- 9. Contestants will be disqualified should they be unable to keep peppers down during contest.
- 10. Contestants will be allowed to finish any pepper remaining in their mouth when time is called.
- 11. Should there be a tie, contestants will compete in another 5 minute competition.
- 12. All judging decisions are final.
