All financial assistance is paid directly to third parties on behalf of CARE through our fiscal sponsor, Community Action Agency of Southern New Mexico.

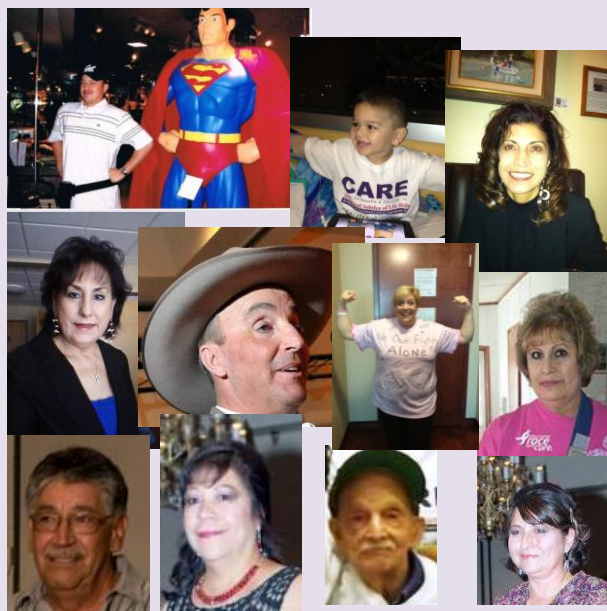
CARE's ASSISTANCE
